Daniel's dad has kindly offered to come in and demonstrate the use of compound materials in concrete construction.</p> <p>Soon after we will be starting our Planet Earth Unit which ties in strongly with our upcoming Jasper trip.</p>	<p><u>Health</u></p> <p>Mrs. Bruinsma is about to start the Human Sexuality Unit – "Male and Female He Created Them". As with all subjects at Covenant Christian School, this unit will be taught from a Christian Perspective. The main through-lines that we will focus on are Idolatry-Discerning and Image-Reflecting. The key areas of study include: examining the human reproductive process and the ways in which God designed this, appreciating the gifts of sexuality and relationships, demonstrating a deeper understanding of God's norms for sexuality, and examining how society (media, culture) influences us. Our essential questions are "What is Love?" and "Where is my Happily-ever After?".</p>

We will be exploring the humble circle and its relationship with the infamous value of <math>\pi</math>.
