 - We were polled on five different questions: Standardized Testing (PATS), Covid Mitigation (is it strong enough), Diploma Exams during pandemic, Vaccinations for 5-11 year olds, Mental Health (how are kids are doing)
 - Dr. Amy Von HeyKing gave a presentation on the new curriculum draft for K - grade 6. Curriculum has always been a hot debate. A high quality curriculum should develop an understanding of the subject matter. Students should be able to implement what they have learned in real life and not just repeat back information they have learned.
