- 3. Principal Report
  - Donavin Simmons
    - 1. Christian Teacher Convention was yet again a time of renewal and growth. Members of Covenant staff were given the opportunity to serve by leading worship.

# Parent comment

- 1. Concerned the mandate will take away the freedom of choice. Jon Ganton (Division Principal) explained that Black Gold took over a month to talk with AHS, Minister of Health and Minister of Education before updating their Administrative Procedure. Black Gold has gone with recommendations of who is in charge (Minister of Health and Education). The Administrative Procedure was passed by Superintendent, Bill Romanchuk, and at any time it can be amended.
- 2. Discussed how we can support Covenant staff that have chosen not to be vaccinated. Concerns about financial burdens on staff who pay out of pocket for testing come January 2022. A suggestion was made that a group of willing parents could donate to a fund that unvaccinated teachers could draw from to pay for testing. Privacy was a concern.
- 3. Concerned about vaccination clinics in schools and parent consent. It was discussed that all parents would be notified ahead of time if any vaccination clinics were in the school and all children eligible for vaccination would have to receive parent consent in advance.
