### **REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS**

### **RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM**

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2024-2025 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2025-2026 are automatically registered for the 2025-2026 school year.

\*Please Note that Preschool students who will be attending Kindergarten are not automatically registered even if they attended a Black Gold school in the previous year. These students will need to register.\*

All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2025-2026 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.

# EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES (ECS): KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS

#### KINDERGARTEN:

**English Program:** Monday/Wednesdays and scheduled Fridays OR Tuesday/Thursdays and scheduled Fridays **Staggered entry dates:** August 27 & 28, 2025. Parents will be informed of their child's date and time by the Kindergarten teacher in mid-August. Parents registering after this date will be informed by phone call on August 26, 2025.

Regular ECS classes commence: Tuesday, September 2 – T/Th class, Wednesday, September 3 - M/W class

Warning bell: 8:30 AM

Lunch Hour: 11:55 AM - 12:30 PM (Subject to change for Kindergarten students)

Dismissal time: 3:15 PM

### PRE-KINDERGARTEN/PRESCHOOL:

Covenant offers a Preschool program privately run by the LSCE. Please call Lisa Gatzke at 780-612-1557 to register.

Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten (EI-PreK) is offered at Calmar Elementary School, École Bellevue School, École Corinthia Park School, Linsford Park School, Robina Baker Elementary School, and Thorsby Elementary School. If you have a preschooler who faces challenges like following directions, communication issues, anxiety, or developmental delays, early intervention is crucial. Our Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten (EI-PreK) program provides specialized support to help your child thrive – academically, socially, and emotionally. Children may qualify as early as two years eight months old by August 31st of the respective school year if they meet the criteria. Please go to

### English as an Additional Language (EAL) Junior Kindergarten:

The EAL Junior Kindergarten program is a half-day program, four days a week, led by a certified teacher with an Education Assistant at École Dansereau Meadows School in Beaumont and Willow Park School in Leduc. Children may qualify as early as three years eight months old by August 31st of the respective school year if

To ensure a balance of strengths and needs across all programs, program times will be communicated directly by the school to all eligible families in September once school staff have had the opportunity to meet all the children in person and perform any necessary assessments.
