We ask that you make two dozen (with the exception of loaves and pies) of which ever treat you sign up to make and deliver them to the school on **April 16 & 17**.

To avoid crumbling please do not bag cookies, putting them on a tray or disposable plate works well. We ask that cookies, cupcakes, muffins, or buns please be packaged in bags of six. Saturday, April 18th we will be doing any last minute set up starting at 8:30am. Doors open at 10:00.

When you arrive at the Marketplace you will need to sign in at the registration table to receive your Bid/Tab number.

Tab numbers: for your convenience all rooms (with the exception of the Games Gallery) and the auction will take your tab number as payment, at the end of the day you can pay your final bill in the pay station room (located in the Preschool room) with **cash, debit, credit or check.**

Kid Tabs: are available for purchase and can be used in all rooms including the Games Gallery.

- ★ Marketplace (the Games Gallery, Cafe, Shops, Bakery, and The Book Nook) will run from 10:00am - 12:30pm
- ★ The Bistro will be open for lunch from 11:00am - 3:00pm
- ★ The Theatre 4 Kids movie will start at 1:00pm
- ★ Silent Auction from 10:00am - 2:00pm
- ★ Live Auction from 1:00pm - 4:00pm

At the end of your visit please make your way to our pay station to settle your tabs with cash, debit, credit or check made out to **Leduc Society for Christian Education.**

The BIG clean up will begin immediately after the completion of the auction, it really is true that many hands make light work!
