#2 - Alberta Health Services made a presentation to the grade nine class last week about the vaccinations recommended at this age. The vaccines are administered at the school, but won't be done until sometime early in the new year.

There is a form for the students to fill out which is in their health class in google classroom. Since a lot of kids have been away this week, could you remind your child to fill out the form, please and thanks.
