# Curriculum

# LANGUAGE ARTS

We will soon begin our writing unit on Organization. The students will be learning how to create Bold Beginnings, Mighty Middles and Excellent Endings.

<u>We are celebrating Dr. Seuss Week!</u> Check the calendar below for all of the dress-up days! These should be things you have around the house - no need to buy any costumes! <u>Practice UFLI Spelling Words often</u> to help your child to grow in their understanding of how words work. A small orange list is stapled to their agenda on Mondays and we do the check-in on Fridays.

<u>Monthly Home Reading</u>: Once again, we have set personal reading goals and they should be recorded on the monthly agenda calendars. We are trusting the kids to mark their calendars when they read for at least 10 minutes (We remind them often in class!). Feel free to initial it as well. At the end of the month, we will pass out a very small prize (bookmark, pencil, stickers) for those who have met their goal.

#### MATH

We are working with Ms. Eldridge on our unit on Addition and Subtraction to 18. <u>Please help your child practice his or her basic facts to 20 over this month</u>. This will help your child find even greater success for our next unit on Adding and Subtracting to 100. Our Ninja Math skills are definitely coming in handy!

# **BIBLE**

We are continuing to learn about the many Names of God each week, and applying that to our everyday lives. We have begun our Bible unit on the Passion Week: the Easter Story. We are looking forward to walking through the stories surrounding the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The memory verse for this unit is: Romans 5:6&8 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners. Christ died for us.
