LANGUAGE ARTS

We have learned how to make BOLD BEGINNINGS in our writing. We will soon learn how to make MIGHTY MIDDLES and EXCELLENT ENDINGS. I am impressed with how far the students' writing has come over these past few months! To grow in our reading and writing abilities, we will soon start our 2nd novel study: Charlotte's Web. Keep encouraging your child to read and write at home!

*Practice UFLI Spelling Words to help your child to grow in their understanding of how words work.

*Monthly Home Reading: Thank you for being diligent and encouraging your child to succeed at reading.

MATH

We have almost finished our unit on Addition and Subtraction to 18. This has been a tricky unit for some, so I encourage you to continue practicing those math facts! Next, we will be working on adding and subtracting double digit numbers to 100. The kids should all know their addition and subtraction facts to 20. We are practicing this at school through Ninja Math, math games (both with cards, dice and on the computer) and flash cards. Extra practice at home is highly encouraged!

SCIENCE

Ms. Eldridge is finishing up our unit on Earth: studying plants, animals and humans in God's World. We have been having fun discovering the wonder of God's creation through these amazing lessons.

SOCIAL

Our next unit in Social will be the dynamic community of Saskatoon, SK! We will discover how Saskatoon is similar to our community of Leduc and area.

PE&W

In Wellness, we are continuing our unit on healthy eating. Next, we will be taking a look at financial literacy and the difference between needs and wants. This is important to consider as we learn how to be good stewards of all of God's many blessings to us.
