**English Language Arts (ELA)**

- As we identify the purpose, form, and structure of a variety of texts and how these texts communicate ideas and information, we will create a variety of written texts to share information and develop personal expression. As well, we will continue to examine and apply grammar, spelling, and punctuation to develop concise written communication.

**Math**

- We are wrapping up the unit on developing number sense in **multiplication**. The Unit test will be soon. Look for a study guide coming home. Our next unit is Division. ***Knowing single digit multiplication is very important - continue practicing at home.***

**Bible**

- We will have a unit test soon (the date will be given in student agendas) on the unit: **Review from Creation through Joshua**. The lives of the Old Testament people show how God revealed Himself to them and led them into a relationship of love and obedience to Him. We've been discussing the fact that the main character in our stories is God and He is working through and revealed through the lives of the characters.

### Social Studies (SS)

- The students have collected information about their Alberta Story and will be creating a Google Slides Presentation to share with the class as we celebrate everyone's story and God's faithfulness to all of us.

### Science

- Our current unit is **Waste in God's World**. This unit has three main parts:
  - a. God has a plan!* God has created natural systems, with plants, animals and other living things made up of materials that are recycled through the environment again and again.
  - b. There is waste in our world.* Students learn about wastes produced through natural processes and human technology. Students also identify wastes produced within their community and learn the methods used for disposal.
  - c. Hope for the future - we're invited to participate in Kingdom work!* Students learn that personal action in reducing, reusing and recycling materials can help decrease the waste we accumulate.
